*The intensive, semi-intensive, and TOEFL/MELAB preparations course programs all follow the same six-week term schedule. Students in all three programs study five days a week during the six-week term (Monday through Friday). Students enrolled in the **intensive study program** receive twenty classroom hours of instruction per week (4 courses) with the option of taking eight additional weekly hours of **TOEFL/MELAB preparation** (theory and workshop). Students enrolled in the **semi-intensive study program** receive 15 or fewer classroom hours of instruction per week (3 or fewer courses) during the same six-week term (also Monday through Friday). Students may also enroll for TOEFL/MELAB preparation only. These students receive eight classroom and workshop hours of instruction per week.

Information For International Students

- A prospective international student must be at least 17 years of age.
- A prospective international student must complete and sign the Access International application form.
- Prospective international students must show evidence that they possess the financial solvency to maintain their full-time student status during the duration of their study experience in the United States by providing the school with:
 - A recent bank statement (the prospective student or his or her parent or relative sponsor) showing at least \$14,000 U.S. or the foreign currency equivalent on deposit, or;
 - An Affidavit of Support signed by the prospective student's American sponsor.
- Prospective international students and their sponsors must sign and return Access International's Statement of Financial Solvency.
- Prospective international students must either show evidence of a health insurance policy that will cover their medical expenses in the U.S. or purchase an international student health insurance policy (available through the school) and show evidence of the same prior to acceptance.
- Upon completion of the above requirements, and upon acceptance by the school, the prospective international student will be issued a Certificate of Eligibility and a Letter of Acceptance to be used for consideration and processing by appropriate officials at an American Consulate abroad.
